CHELSEA SOLAR LLC’S CONSENTED TO MOTION TO REVISE SCHEDULE

On July 17, 2018, the Town of Bennington (the “Town”) requested that Chelsea Solar LLC (“Chelsea”) agree to an extension of the Town’s time to respond to discovery requests from July 20, 2018 until July 31, 2018. Chelsea stated that it was agreeable to the Town’s request provided that the remainder of the schedule between now and the evidentiary hearing was also adjusted. As a result, Chelsea, the Town, the Department of Public Service, Lora Block, Libby Harris and Maru Leon have each agreed upon the following schedule:

August 31, 2018	Deadline for Petitioner to respond to discovery
September 14, 2018	Non-Petitioner parties file sur-rebuttal
September 19-21, 2018	Evidentiary Hearing
October 5, 2018	Parties file post-hearing briefs with proposed findings of fact and order
October 19, 2018	Parties file post-hearing reply briefs

Wherefore Chelsea moves that the schedule in this case be revised as set forth above.
