On July 9, 2018, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) initiated this investigation in response to Section 25 of Act 158 (H.917) of the 2017-2018 Vermont legislative session to identify and remove barriers to increased ownership and usage of electric vehicles (“EVs”) in Vermont. In the Commission’s August 8, 2018 Order re Scope and Schedule (“Order”), the Commission scheduled a workshop for October 1 and identified six topics to be discussed at the workshop. Participants who wish to make a presentation on any of these topics must submit their request to the Commission by September 17, 2018. Please accept this filing as Green Mountain Power’s (“GMP”) request to make a presentation at the workshop.

GMP proposes to provide the Commission and other stakeholders with background information on the work GMP has done to promote EV ownership and charging infrastructure and to address the following Commission topics:

- barriers to the widespread deployment of EV charging stations in Vermont;
- barriers to the widespread ownership and use of EVs in Vermont; and
- strategies for the removal of any barriers.

GMP recognizes that several parties may wish to present, and GMP will be flexible regarding which topics it presents as well as the amount of time for its presentation.
