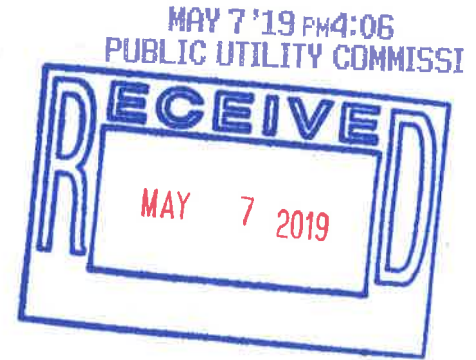

REQUEST FOR EXTENSION TO FILE RECOMMENDATION


On July 24, 2018, the Public Utility Commission issued a Procedural Order in this matter in which the Hearing Officer indicated “Within 14 days of the issuance of the final decision in Vermont Supreme Court Case No. 2018-120, the parties shall file recommendations on next steps in this investigation, including if necessary, proposed schedules for moving this matter to its conclusion.”

On April 26, 2019, the Vermont Supreme Court issued its Entry Order in Supreme Court Case No. 2018-120. As a result, the parties’ recommendations would be due May 10, 2019.

The Department is requesting an extension to May 31, 2019 for the parties to file their recommendation. The Town of Irasburg, the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources and Mr. Blittersdorf have no objection to the extension requested.
