RECOMMENDATION FOR STATUS CONFERENCE

On July 24, 2018, the Public Utility Commission issued a Procedural Order in this matter in which the Hearing Officer indicated “Within 14 days of the issuance of the final decision in Vermont Supreme Court Case No. 2018-120, the parties shall file recommendations on next steps in this investigation, including if necessary, proposed schedules for moving this matter to its conclusion.”


On April 26, 2019, the Vermont Supreme Court issued its Entry Order in Supreme Court Case No. 2018-120. As a result, the parties’ recommendations would have been due May 10, 2019.

By Order dated May 9, 2019, the Commission granted the Department’s unchallenged request to extend the recommendation due date to May 31, 2019.

It is the Department’s recommendation that a status conference be held in order to identify how best to proceed and establish a schedule by which this matter can be brought to a conclusion. Counsel for Mr. Blittersdorf has no objection to this request.
