Proposed revisions to Vermont Public Utility Commission Rule 5.100	
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MOTION TO CHANGE SCHEDULE

On April 16, 2019 the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) opened this rulemaking to review Commission Rule 5.100. In an Order dated August 22, 2019 the Commission requested additional information to assist in this proceeding and set the deadline for comments as October 18, 2019, with replies due November 1, 2019.

On October 16, 2019, the Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a *Motion to Change Schedule* requesting an additional two weeks to submit its comments due to “illness and unavailability among Department staff.” On October 17, 2019, the Commission granted the Department’s request and extended the comment deadline for all parties to submit comments until November 1, 2019 and extended the response deadline to November 15, 2019.

On November 1, 2019 Renewable Energy Vermont (“REV”), the Department, Vermont Public Power Supply Authority, Burlington Electric Department, Washington Electric Cooperative, Vermont Electric Cooperative, Town of Stowe Electric Department and Green Mountain Power (and others) filed extensive, detailed comments encompassing hundreds of pages and numerous complex spreadsheets.

In order to ensure that REV and all other parties can provide comprehensive and thorough responses to the comments submitted, REV requests that the Commission provide additional time for all participants in this Case to file responses. This extension would move the response date to Friday, November 29, 2019, but given the intervening holiday on November 28, 2019 REV suggests that the response date be extended to December 6, 2019.

REV conferred with the following parties that stated they support or have no objection to this request to extend the schedule: Green Mountain Power, Stowe Electric Department, Washington Electric Coop, Vermont Agency of Agriculture, Food & Markets, Vermont Agency of Natural Resources, Vermonters for Clean Environment, Vermont Department of Public Service, Vermont Electric Coop, VPPSA.
