
Triland fully supports the Commission's proposal to grant a one-year extension of all commissioning deadlines for net metering and standard offer projects whose commissioning deadlines fall on or after March 25, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

Triland further requests, in conjunction with any Order to extend commissioning deadlines, the Commission authorize, enable and direct Vermont's utilities to similarly extend, for net metering and standard offer projects, the execution deadline of all Standard Generation Interconnection Agreements whose execution deadlines fall on or after March 25, 2020 through December 31, 2020. This extension will be critical to preserving the interconnection queue positions for the very same projects requiring the protection of a commissioning deadline extension.
