On October 6, 2020, the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) asked the City of Burlington Electric Department (“BED”) to update charts and tables in its proposed demand resource plan (“DRP”) to match the testimony provided. With this filing, BED informs the Hearing Officer of its recent filing in a related proceeding concerning the electric efficiency charge (i.e. Case 20 – 2022). In the letter, which is being filed concurrently with this letter, BED is requesting the Commission to postpone rendering an opinion in the case. For the reasons expressed in BED’s letter to the Commission in 20 – 2022, BED requests that the Commission also postpone rendering a decision in this proceeding. As noted, BED will be submitting an amended DRP budget by October 30, 2020.
