Enclosed for filing, on behalf of Franklin Telephone Company, Inc. ("Franklin"), is Franklin's revised disconnection notice, submitted in compliance with the Commission's Rule 7.622(E)(2), as amended by the Commission's Emergency Rule 2.604, effective October 15, 2020.

The Emergency Rule adopted temporary amendments to Rule 7.602(H) (Form of Disconnection Notice) applicable to providers of basic residential telephone service, such as Franklin, and also amended Rule 7.622(E)(2) by requiring such providers to submit to the Commission, for its review and approval, a revised disconnection notice in compliance with amended Rule 7.620(H).
