On October 15, 2020, the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an emergency disconnection rule and required utilities to file copies of their disconnection notices within seven days. Pursuant to the emergency rule, enclosed is Green Mountain Power’s residential disconnection notice. As detailed in earlier filings in this case, even though the moratorium on disconnections has been lifted, GMP does not plan to disconnect customers for nonpayment at least through the end of this calendar year.
