### **Notice of Integrated Resource Plan Filing**

Stowe Electric Department (“Stowe”) recently submitted our 2020 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP) to the Vermont Public Utility Commission (PUC) for review. Stowe’s IRP is the utility’s proposed plan to meet the customer’s need for the safe, reliable, least cost, and environmentally compliant electricity service.

30 V.S.A §202(f), <https://legislature.vermont.gov/statutes/section/30/005/00202>, requires each Vermont utility to conduct least cost integrated planning and include an analysis of each utility’s generation needs, supply resources; planned improvements, and the costs associated with generation resources. Utilities file an IRP with the PUC and the Vermont Public Service Department (DPS) at least once every three years. Filing an IRP with PUC and DPS allows for State agencies to review and determine a utility’s IRP is consistent with the Vermont Electric Plan and 2016 Comprehensive Energy Plan.
