Green Mountain Power (“GMP”) is writing in response to the Public Utility Commission’s November 25, 2020 Order requesting comments regarding whether it is appropriate to grant a one-year extension of all commissioning deadlines for net-metering and standard-offer projects with commissioning deadlines falling on or after December 31, 2020, through March 1, 2021. GMP recognizes that with this extension, it is possible more projects will reach final commissioning under the current rate schedule than would occur without the extension, at some additional cost to customers, although we cannot now quantify that impact. In light of the unprecedented challenges created by the pandemic, however, GMP does not oppose this solution in order to provide both procedural clarity and fair accommodation to project developers.
