ORDER GRANTING PARTIES' MOTION TO ALTER POST-HEARING SCHEDULE

As requested by the parties, we issue the following post-hearing schedule:




January 8, 2021 – ANR Responds to Developer’s revised discovery requests.

February 12, 2021 – Reply briefs due.


