ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR RESPONSE


This case involves a petition filed with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) by Charter Fiberlink VT-CCO, LLC (“Charter Fiberlink”), seeking designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier in Vermont.

On March 2, 2021, Charter Fiberlink filed a motion to extend the time for responding to comments filed by the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) to allow additional time for discussions between the parties. The Department does not object to the requested extension of time.

SO ORDERED.


