Green Mountain Power (“GMP”) has received the motions to intervene filed by Vermont Public Power Supply Authority (“VPPSA”) and the City of Burlington Electric Department (“BED”) in the above-referenced proceedings and writes to advise the Commission that it has no objection to the admission of either VPPSA or BED as parties in both proceedings. GMP engaged in outreach and discussion with the other Vermont distributed utilities, including both VPPSA and BED, prior to the initial filings in these matters. As noted in the prefiled testimony of Joshua Castonguay filed in both proceedings, GMP and the other utilities are in the process of finalizing a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) for which the parties have reached an agreement in principle on terms and conditions. The MOU addresses items raised in VPPSA’s and BED’s respective Motions to Intervene, and GMP will file the MOU when it is finalized.
