RESPONSE OF EFFICIENCY VERMONT TO THE
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On April 13, 2021, the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued a Procedural Order requesting comments by April 22, 2021 on Efficiency Vermont’s proposal for the 2021 Fixed Monthly Energy Efficiency Charge (“EEC”) that is scheduled to go into effect on July 2, 2021. On April 14, 2021, the Department of Public Service (“Department”) requested a two-week extension to this deadline, to May 6, 2021, to file its comments and explained that the extension was necessary for the Department to obtain the information necessary to review Efficiency Vermont’s proposal and to meet internal review deadlines. By this filing Efficiency Vermont informs the Commission that it supports the granting of the Department’s extension request.

In addition, Efficiency Vermont requests that the Commission extend the due date for comments an additional seven days, to May 13, 2021, so the schedule creates the opportunity for Efficiency Vermont to collaborate with the Department, respond to its requests for information, and develop any amendments to the 2021 Fixed Monthly EEC proposal as may be necessary or appropriate to address recommendations that may be proposed by the Department. To the extent that any revisions or amendments to Efficiency Vermont’s Fixed Monthly EEC proposal are developed, Efficiency Vermont proposes that they also be filed with the Commission on May 13, 2021.

Efficiency Vermont believes that this schedule adjustment should enable the Commission's process to proceed, creates the opportunity for the submission of a consensus Fixed Monthly EEC Rate proposal, and will provide the Department reasonable opportunity to conduct its information gathering and internal review processes.
