Green Mountain Power has received the Motion to Alter or Amend the Commission's *Order Granting BED's and VPPSA's Motions to Intervene* filed by Vermont Public Power Supply Authority ("VPPSA") and the Burlington Electric Department ("BED") in the above-referenced proceedings. GMP does not oppose BED and VPPSA's motion. For context, GMP interpreted the footnote in question to be a statement that this proceeding was not focused on establishing any general standards or criteria applicable to any potential future petitions. As emphasized in both the Section 231 and 249 petitions in these proceedings, GLOBALFOUNDRIES U.S. 2 LLC is in a unique position, and consideration of both its request and any other petition in the future would require detailed, individualized review under the relevant statutory criteria. Nonetheless, GMP has no objection at all to BED and VPPSA's participation without limitation.
