Green Mountain Power (“GMP”) has received the Motions to Intervene filed by AllEarth Renewables, Inc., Renewable Energy Vermont, and the Conservation Law Foundation in the above-referenced proceedings. GMP does not object to the Commission granting permissive intervention to any of these entities in both proceedings. GMP will work with all parties toward agreement on a proposed revised schedule that accommodates discovery for the new intervenors but still provides the Commission with the ability to issue a decision later this year, as requested by GlobalFoundries and GMP for the reasons stated in their respective testimony. GMP expects that a revised proposed schedule will be filed no later than May 11, jointly with the other parties if possible, or separately if the parties cannot reach agreement.
