SCHEDULING ORDER

These cases concern GlobalFoundries U.S. 2 LLC's ("GlobalFoundries") petition for a certificate of public good, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 231, to operate an independent, self-managed utility beginning October 1, 2022, under *de minimis* regulation appropriate to its function and Green Mountain Power Corporation's ("GMP") petition for approval to modify its service territory, pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 249.

While the Commission is not consolidating these cases, the proceedings and hearings in the two cases will be scheduled jointly pursuant to Vermont Rule of Civil Procedure 42(a), per the parties' request.

After the scheduling conference held on April 9, 2021, the Commission adopted the parties' proposed procedural schedule, with a few modifications.

On May 14, 2021, the parties filed a stipulated-to motion to amend the schedule. On May 17, 2021, Vermont Transco, LLC and Vermont Electric Power Company, Inc. filed a letter confirming that they also have consented to the proposed amended schedule.

The Commission adopts the parties' proposed amended schedule, below. The Commission has included the parties' agreed-upon deadlines for "initial motions," "responses to initial motions," and "replies in support of initial motions." However, in doing so, the Commission is not foreclosing the opportunity for parties to file motions when appropriate, pursuant to Commission Rules or the Vermont Rules of Civil Procedure.



Further, the Commission acknowledges that the parties had previously requested an order be issued in these cases by November 15, 2021, or, at the latest, by the end of 2021. The Commission notes that the amended schedule proposed by the parties and adopted here may result in a final order being issued after the parties' requested December 31, 2021, deadline.


