Green Mountain Power (“GMP”) writes to express its support for the revised proposed schedule filed in the above-referenced proceeding by the Department of Public Service (“DPS or “Department”). The Department’s proposal balances the needs of this case by requiring earlier presentation of any potential Memorandum of Understanding between DPS, GLOBALFOUNDRIES U.S. 2 LLC (“GF”) and the Agency of Natural Resources and allowing discovery and testimony on that issue, while still allowing the proceeding to follow the original schedule as closely a possible, which is important given GMP’s upcoming rate case and the related expiration of the existing GF term contract.
