DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULE

The Department of Public Service (“Department”) herby moves the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) to amend the schedule in this matter. The Department respectfully requests that the Commission amend the existing schedule in order to allow the parties additional time to respond to the Commission’s September 28, 2021 information request. Because the contract between the Department and its consultant GDS Associates, Inc. (“GDS”) was limited in time and compensation, the Department was unable to engage with GDS over the past month. A new contract was executed on October 18, 2021.

In order to provide additional funds to GDS and allow ample time to substantively respond to the Commission’s questions, the Department respectfully requests that responses to the information request be due January 7, 2022. I am authorized to state that Green Mountain Power Corporation does not oppose the proposed schedule change.
