**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE RESPONSE TO**  
**KILLINGTON/PICO SKI RESORT PARTNERS, LLC**  
**MOTION FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT**

On March 10, 2022 Killington/Pico Ski Resort Partners, LLC (“Killington”) filed a letter with the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) seeking confidential treatment for a document uploaded into the Commission’s electronic filing system ePUC titled “Killington ESA PO.pdf.” Killington maintains that the specified document contains “sensitive financial information” as the basis for its request.

The Department of Public Service (“Department”) has reviewed Killington’s request and is unable to make a determination with the information provided as to whether the document should qualify for confidential treatment. Killington has not provided a basis for its claim of confidentiality beyond a broad statement that the information is financially sensitive and therefore more specific, explanatory information is required for the Department to respond appropriately. The Department also notes that Killington’s request comes after the company has already uploaded the document at issue into the Commission’s publicly viewable document management system and therefore public disclosure has already occurred.
