PROCEDURAL ORDER REVISING THE SCHEDULE

This proceeding concerns an application filed by Randolph Davis Solar LLC (“Petitioner”) with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) for a certificate of public good (“CPG”) to construct and operate a 500-kW solar group net-metering system in Randolph, Vermont (the proposed “Project”). In my July 1, 2022, Order, I set a revised schedule for the remainder of the proceeding that included an evidentiary hearing to be held on August 12, 2022.

On July 7, 2022, the Petitioner filed a request to extend the deadline for surrebuttal testimony to either September 7, 8, or 9, and that the evidentiary hearing be rescheduled for October 6 or 7. The Petitioner represents that it has shared the proposed alternative dates with the parties and that all parties are agreeable to these dates.


I have shifted the dates in the schedule as requested by the Petitioner. The schedule for the remainder of this proceeding is revised as follows:

Date	Event
September 9, 2022	Surrebuttal testimony due to be filed by all parties; State agencies should file updated comments if they decide not to file surrebuttal testimony
October 6, 2022, at 9:30 A.M.	Evidentiary hearing
October 27, 2022	Briefs and proposed findings of fact due to be filed

November 10, 2022	Reply briefs due to be filed
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SO ORDERED.


