PROCEDURAL ORDER CONCERNING CLARIFICATION OF NOTICE OF APPEARANCE

This proceeding concerns an application filed by Randolph Davis Solar LLC (“Petitioner”) with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) for a certificate of public good (“CPG”) to construct and operate a 500-kW solar group net-metering system in Randolph, Vermont (the proposed “Project”).

On September 25, 2022, L. Brooke Dingledine, Esq., entered a notice of limited appearance for the purpose of acting as counsel for the evidentiary hearing scheduled for October 14, 2022, on behalf of Joan Allen.¹


On September 27, 2022, the Petitioner filed a request for clarification regarding the limited notice of appearance filed by Attorney Dingledine. The Petitioner seeks to clarify whether Attorney Dingledine will appear at the evidentiary hearing to represent the joint interests of the Intervenor in this case.

I request that Attorney Dingledine clarify by October 7, 2022, whether her notice of appearance is to represent the joint interests of Joan Allen and Michael Binder (“Intervenor”) at the evidentiary hearing.

¹ On October 25, 2021, Joan Allen and Michael Binder (“Intervenor”) filed motion to intervene in this proceeding as adjoining landowners. I treated the motion to intervene as a notice of intervention. Commission Rule 5.117(B)(3) provides that certain entities and adjoining landowners will be granted party status by the Commission upon the filing of a notice of intervention. Accordingly, the Intervenor are parties in this proceeding.
