PROCEDURAL ORDER REQUESTING INFORMATION

This proceeding concerns an application filed by Randolph Davis Solar LLC (“Petitioner”) with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) for a certificate of public good (“CPG”) to construct and operate a 500-kW solar group net-metering system in Randolph, Vermont (the proposed “Project”).

On September 9, 2022, Joan Allen and Michael Binder (the “Intervenors”) filed the surrebuttal testimony of Michael Binder. Mr. Binder raises concerns related to the management of stormwater at solar facilities.¹


It would be helpful to have in the record of this case the perspective of the Vermont Agency of Natural Resources (“ANR”) on the issues raised by Mr. Binder. Therefore, I am requesting that ANR explain whether and how Vermont’s stormwater management regulations and the Project’s design will address Mr. Binder’s concerns about locating solar panels on steep slopes.

ANR may respond to this information request by either: (a) filing testimony and making a witness available for questions at the evidentiary hearing, or (b) informing the Commission that ANR will address this question through post-hearing legal briefing. ANR’s response, or testimony, should be filed by no later than November 11, 2022.
