PROCEDURAL ORDER CLARIFYING DISCOVERY PROCEDURES

On January 17, 2023, Efficiency Vermont requested clarification from the Vermont Public Utility Commission ("Commission") regarding its revised Rule 2.000 that goes into effect January 18, 2023. Specifically, Efficiency Vermont requested clarification on whether discovery responses for this proceeding will be managed as they have in previous demand resources plan proceedings or as outlined in the revised Commission Rule 2.230(R).¹

Efficiency Vermont noted that in prior demand resources plan proceedings, participants provided copies of discovery responses and attachments to the Commission and filed them in ePUC. Efficiency Vermont does not object to continuing that practice in this proceeding.

Pursuant to Commission rule 2.30(R)(2), parties are requested to provide copies of discovery responses and attachments to the Commission using ePUC. In the event that any discovery response or attachment exceeds the file-size limit of ePUC, the discovery response or attachment should be emailed to the Clerk of the Commission or otherwise provided to the Commission in electronic format.
