**DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE MOTION TO EXTEND SCHEDULE**

On October 13, 2022, the Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued a schedule in this case pursuant to which the Department of Public Service (“Department”) was due to complete discovery on the Energy Efficiency Utilities (“EEUs”) by January 26, 2023 and file rebuttal testimony with respect to all three EEUs on February 23, 2023. By this motion, the Department respectfully requests a three-week extension to the schedule in this case with respect to the Demand Resource Plans (“DRPs”) submitted by Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. (“VGS”) and City of Burlington Electric Department (“BED”), with the current schedule to remain in place with respect to Efficiency Vermont and the scheduled February 2<sup>nd</sup> Public Utility Commission workshop. The Department is making this request at this time because one of the Department’s key staff responsible for overseeing the Department’s review of VGS’s and BED’s DRPs has recently become ill and is unable to move forward with preparation of the Department’s responsive testimony at this time. If the Commission were to grant this request, the new deadline for the Department’s discovery to be served on VGS and BED would be February 16, 2023 and the deadline for rebuttal testimony with respect to VGS and BED would be March 16, 2023. The remaining dates in the schedule would similarly be extended by three weeks with respect to VGS and BED. The Department has consulted with the EEUs prior to filing this motion and is authorized

to represent that VGS, BED, and Efficiency Vermont do not object to the Department's motion.
