ORDER CONSOLIDATING SCHEDULING CONFERENCES AND GRANTING DISCOVERY EXTENSION

On February 21, 2023, the Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed comments regarding the consolidation of the two currently scheduled status conferences. The Department represents that the parties do not object to convening a single status conference for all three energy efficiency utility Demand Resources Plan proposals on April 21, 2023, with proposed schedules to be filed by April 14, 2023.


In addition, the Department states that it does not object to a one-week extension of the deadline for serving discovery requests on parties’ reply testimony.¹

Absent any objection, I approve the following two changes to the schedule. First, the scheduling conference concerning Efficiency Vermont’s Demand Resources Plan proposal, which is currently scheduled to be held on April 4, 2023, will be rescheduled and consolidated with the scheduling conference concerning the Demand Resources Plan proposals of the City of Burlington Electric Department and Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. This consolidated scheduling conference will be held on April 21, 2023. Second, the deadline for Efficiency Vermont to serve discovery requests on the Department’s reply testimony is extended by one week until March 23, 2023.
