AMENDED ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR A ONE WEEK EXTENSION

On March 14, 2023, the Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a motion with the Vermont Public Utility Commission seeking an extension of time for the Department to file testimony in response to the City of Burlington Electric Department’s (“BED”) Demand Resources Plan proposal. The Department notes that under the current schedule, its testimony would be due on March 16, 2023. However, on March 13, 2023, BED filed a revision to its Demand Resources Plan proposal. The Department requests an additional week to evaluate BED’s revised proposal and prepare responsive testimony. The Department states that its request will not affect the existing schedule with respect to Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. (“VGS”), nor will it affect the April 21st status conference. The Department represents that it has consulted with BED and that BED does not object to the revised schedule.

The Department’s request is reasonable and is therefore granted. The remainder of the existing schedule is as follows.

February 24-March 23, 2023	Discovery requests on parties’ Efficiency Vermont reply testimony, with 14-day response
March 16, 2023	Deadline for reply testimony and exhibits in response to VGS proposal
March 23, 2023	Deadline for reply testimony and exhibits in response to BED proposal
March 17-April 6, 2023	Discovery requests on parties’ VGS reply testimony, with 14-day response
March 24-April 6, 2023	Discovery requests on parties’ BED reply testimony, with 14-day response

April 21, 2023	Scheduling conference to discuss further process, parties to file proposed schedules seven days before scheduling conference (April 14)
