**COMMISSION FOLLOW-UP INFORMATION REQUEST FOR DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE**

This case concerns the petition of the Department of Public Service (“Department”) to open an energy efficiency utility Demand Resources Plan (“DRP”) proceeding. On March 28, 2023, Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) staff issued an information request regarding the evidence filed by the Department addressing its evaluation plan and budget. The information request posed the following question.

Referring to Exhibit DPS-BM-1, please describe the activities and deliverables associated with the proposed \$633,036 evaluation budget labeled “Thermal Energy and Process Fuels BED.” Please explain why this proposed budget is \$18,036 larger than the sum of Cells H16-J16 on the “BED TEPF Revenue Forecast” tab of Exhibit DPS-BM-3.

On April 10, 2023, the Department filed its response to the information request.

The Department’s response explains why the proposed TEPF evaluation budget in exhibit DPS-BM-1 differs from the proposed budget in exhibit DPS-BM-3. However, the Department’s response does not “describe the activities and deliverables” associated with the proposed TEPF evaluation budget. Accordingly, the Department is requested to file supplemental testimony or exhibits that describe the activities and deliverables associated with the proposed \$633,036 evaluation budget labeled “Thermal Energy and Process Fuels BED” in exhibit DPS-BM-1. The Department’s response is requested by April 28, 2023.
