Green Mountain Power (GMP) is writing to voice support for the Flexible Load Management (FLM) work in the Demand Resources Plan proposal submitted by Efficiency Vermont. FLM is a key strategy to reduce peak load and shift load to periods when the energy mix is less costly and clean. That translates to cost and carbon savings for all customers. GMP has been successful in deploying FLM through both building controls and by connecting electric vehicle supply equipment (EVSE) to a platform that can drive down usage during peak events. Our ongoing partnership with Efficiency Vermont helps cover the costs of upgrades needed for building controls as well as customer acquisition. We have developed strong relationships with the account managers who then spread awareness of the program, showing that it is a low cost, low impact improvement for the greater grid. We appreciate the opportunity to provide comments in this proceeding.
