**PROCEDURAL ORDER RE: DEADLINE FOR RESPONSES TO OBJECTION
AND REQUEST FOR JUDICIAL NOTICE**

This case concerns an application filed with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) by Randolph Davis Solar LLC (“Applicant”) to construct and operate a 500 kW group net-metered solar electric generation system in Randolph, Vermont (the proposed “Project”).

On October 11, 2023, the Commission issued an order finding that the preferred-site letter filed by the Applicant does not conform with Commission Rule 5.103.¹ The Commission ordered that the Applicant must file evidence demonstrating that the Town of Randolph Planning Commission and Selectboard have reviewed the Applicant’s survey data and agrees that the Project’s solar panels will not be on slopes greater than 25% and satisfies the Town’s condition as stated in Exh. RDS-MS-14.

On January 9, 2024, the Applicant filed a letter² from the chairs of the Town of Randolph Planning Commission and Selectboard verifying that the site plan (Exh. RDS-MS-2A) shows that the condition stated in Exh. RDS-MS-14 has been satisfied.

On January 23, 2024, Joan Allen and Michael Binder (the “Landowners”) filed an objection to the public comment³ and evidence filed by the Applicant on January 9, 2024. The Landowners also filed a request for judicial notice of a Commission order.

Responses to the Landowners' objection and request for judicial notice must be filed by no later than February 6, 2024.


