PROCEDURAL ORDER REVISING SCHEDULE

This case involves a petition filed by Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP”) with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”), pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 218d and Section IV(A)(6) of GMP’s current multi-year rate plan (“MYRP”), for authorization to spend up to \$250 million in additional transmission and distribution investments over the final two years of the MYRP.¹

On November 30, 2023, the Commission issued an order setting a litigation schedule for this case.

On March 6, 2024, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a motion to modify the schedule in this case. The Department seeks to extend the deadline for filing its direct testimony to March 15, 2024. This change would result in corresponding adjustments to future rounds of discovery and testimony deadlines. It would also extend the scheduled date for an evidentiary hearing to the week of May 20, 2024. The Department states these adjustments are necessary to accommodate process needs. The Department also represents that GMP consents to the proposed scheduling revisions.




Based on the agreement of the parties, and because the Department’s proposed revisions will not unnecessarily delay the resolution of this case, we grant the Department’s motion and adopt the schedule below for the remainder of this proceeding.

¹ The MYRP, which governs GMP’s rates through September 30, 2026, was approved by the Commission on August 31, 2022, in Case No. 21-3707-PET. *Petition of Green Mountain Power Corporation for approval of a new Multi-Year Regulation Plan pursuant to 30 V.S.A. Sections 209, 218, and 218d*, Case No. 21-3707-PET, Order of 8/31/22.
