TARIFF FILING OF Woodstock Aqueduct Company

RE: PROPOSED RATE INCREASE

Important Notice Regarding Upcoming Rate Changes

Woodstock Aqueduct Company has filed a request with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) for approval to increase the Company’s rates. As explained in Woodstock’s filing with the Commission, the rate request is needed to address severe damage to the town water system caused by the Summer 2023 flooding. We are also seeking a change in rates that will support much needed infrastructure investments that are required by the State of Vermont Drinking Water and Groundwater Protection Division to bring fire hydrants in town into compliance with Vermont Water Supply Rules.

If approved by the Commission, customers Base Charge will increase from \$240.00 a year to \$503.56 per year, the Variable Charge based on customer usage volumes will change from \$0.03 to \$0.07 per gallon, and the hydrant charges billed to the Town of Woodstock will increase from \$360.00 to \$3,804.92. This request has been filed with the Vermont Public Utility Commission via ePUC, the Commission’s online case and document management system. The Commission will initiate a process for public input. In the meantime, customers are encouraged to provide comments to the Commission at any time.
