PROCEDURAL ORDER REVISING SCHEDULE

This case involves a petition filed by Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP”) with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”), pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 218d and Section IV(A)(6) of GMP’s current multi-year rate plan (“MYRP”), for authorization to spend up to \$250 million in additional transmission and distribution investments over the final two years of the MYRP.¹

On November 30, 2023, we issued an order setting a litigation schedule for this case.

On March 8, 2024, we issued a procedural order revising the schedule for this case.

On April 5, 2024, GMP filed a motion to further modify the schedule for this case. GMP seeks an extension of the deadline to file rebuttal testimony from April 10, 2024, to April 15, 2024. GMP also proposes to change the dates for evidentiary hearings from May 23 and 24, 2024, to May 29 and 30, 2024, and several other intervening deadlines. GMP’s states that its proposed scheduling revisions are due to extensive planning and restoration efforts that followed the winter storm that affected Vermont on April 3-5, 2024. GMP represents that the Department of Public Service (“Department”) supports the proposed scheduling changes.




Based on the agreement of the parties and because GMP has shown good cause for the requested scheduling changes, we grant GMP’s motion and adopt the following schedule for the remainder of this proceeding:

¹ The MYRP, which governs GMP’s rates through September 30, 2026, was approved by the Commission on August 31, 2022, in Case No. 21-3707-PET. *Petition of Green Mountain Power Corporation for approval of a new Multi-Year Regulation Plan pursuant to 30 V.S.A. Sections 209, 218, and 218d*, Case No. 21-3707-PET, Order of 8/31/22.
