**PROCEDURAL ORDER CORRECTING REVISING SCHEDULE**

This case involves a petition filed by Green Mountain Power Corporation (“GMP”) with the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”), pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 218d and Section IV(A)(6) of GMP’s current multi-year rate plan (“MYRP”), for authorization to spend up to \$250 million in additional transmission and distribution investments over the final two years of the MYRP.<sup>1</sup>

On April 9, 2024, the Commission issued an order revising the litigation schedule for this case. That order did not, however, correctly incorporate all dates that the parties proposed for the remainder of this proceeding. Therefore, the schedule is further amended to comport with the parties’ scheduling proposal as follows:

June 21, 2024	Reply briefs due
