

The remaining witnesses will be attending the hearing regardless, but if the Commission has no questions for those witnesses for whom cross-examination has not been requested, the parties request that the Commission advise in the event the witness need not attend the hearing.

The undersigned counsel is authorized to state that the parties have agreed to the stipulation and admission of all prefiled testimony and exhibits. A comprehensive list of testimony and exhibits from all parties will be submitted by GMP prior to the hearing as requested by the Commission.
