**WOODSTOCK AQUEDUCT COMPANY’S WAIVER OF
SEVEN-MONTH DEADLINE PURSUANT TO 30 V.S.A. § 227(a)**

By this filing Woodstock Aqueduct Company (“WAC”) hereby waives the statutory seven-month deadline pursuant to 30 V.S.A. § 227(a) for a period of one-month until January 16, 2025 and renews its request to extend the briefing schedule by two weeks as set forth in WAC’s October 18, 2024 motion to extend the deadline for briefing in this matter.

On October 18, 2024, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an Order Denying Extension to Briefing Schedule, explaining that “unless Woodstock Aqueduct agrees to waive the seven-month deadline pursuant to 30 V.S.A § 227(a) for an amount of time at least commensurate with any requested extension to the briefing schedule,” the Commission cannot adopt the amended briefing schedule because it would not allow sufficient time for the issuance of proposal for decision, party comments, and a final order before December 16, 2024.

By this filing, WAC hereby waives the statutory deadline under Section 227(a) for a period of one month and requests that the Commission adopt the proposed two-week extension of the briefing schedule. This waiver will extend the statutory period in this matter until January 16, 2025, and WAC is also amenable to considering a further waiver of the period if doing so will assist the Department and Commission’s review of this matter.
