About four years ago we had two condensers and three heat pump heads installed in our two story home. We tried one month in December to heat with the heat pumps for a month with two subzero nights. Electric bill jumped from \$148 to \$395. Our regular budget plan payment with our fuel supplier which covers dryer, hot water and heating costs for propane is \$200 per month. We couldn't see ourselves continuing to incur \$400 plus dollars per month using the heat pump units when we can affordably heat and dry clothes and heat our hot water for \$200 per month using propane. The heat pumps are wonderful as cooling systems but at least in our case, not for heating our home!
