**MOTION TO AMEND BRIEFING SCHEDULE AND  
WAIVER OF STATUTORY PERIOD**

Woodstock Aqueduct Company (“WAC”) moves to amend the briefing schedule in the above captioned case to allow the parties to present supplemental testimony regarding the Department of Public Service’s (“Department”) recommendations about potential methods to fund needed capital projects. In lieu of filing Initial Briefs on November 5, 2024, and Reply Briefs on November 15, 2024, WAC moves for the schedule to be amended to allow the Department to file supplemental testimony on November 12, 2024 and WAC to file its response to the Department’s supplemental testimony on November 22, 2024.

Additionally, WAC hereby waives the statutory period for a decision to issue in this case for another week, extending its prior waiver from January 16, 2025, to January 23, 2025. If additional briefing is necessary following these filings, WAC will further waive the statutory period for a decision in this matter to allow further briefing.
