**ORDER RE: COMMENTS ON PALMER MOTION TO INVESTIGATE NON-SUBSTANTIAL CHANGE
REQUEST**

On April 3, 2015, Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. ("VGS") requested that the Vermont Public Service Board (the "Board") issue a non-substantial change determination relating to five proposed modifications to the Addison Natural Gas Project. On April 8, 2015, the Board directed that all party comments on the VGS request be filed no later than the close of business on Friday, April 24, 2015. On April 24, 2015, Nathan Palmer, representing the Palmers *pro se*, filed comments including a motion (the "Palmer Motion") requesting that the Board "open an investigation into whether an amendment to the CPG is necessary"¹ based on the VGS request for a non-substantial change determination. Any party may file responsive comments to the Palmer Motion by May 15, 2015.
