**ORDER RE: SECOND EXTENSION OF COMMENTS ON HURLBURT MOTION TO DELAY
CONSTRUCTION IN THE VELCO CORRIDOR**

On July 7, 2014, the Public Service Board ("Board") granted a request of the Agency of Natural Resources ("ANR") to extend the deadline for comment on the Hurlburt Motion to Delay Construction in the VELCO Corridor (the "Hurlburt Motion") to July 14, 2014. On July 14, 2014, ANR requested a further extension until July 28, 2014, the same date that ANR and the other parties have been ordered to comment on Vermont Gas Systems, Inc.'s ("VGS's") soil management plan filing due on July 21, 2014.¹ ANR states that VGS's July 21 filing will inform its comments on the Hurlburt Motion. ANR also represents that both the Department of Public Service and the Agency of Agriculture, Farm and Markets join in this request for a further extension. The Board hereby grants the requested extension until close of business on July 28, 2014.

1. The Board is concerned about the late timing of this request, which limits the ability of the parties to respond to it.
